absorb the shocks of economic
turbulence, and promoting new
conceptions of faith, spirit, and
will power that contributed to
business. Porterfield highlights
the role that American
religious institutions played a
society increasingly dominated
by commercial incorporation
and free market ideologies. She
also shows how charitable
impulses long nurtured by
religion continued to stimulate
reform and demand for
accountability.
