*Frozen in Ice: The Story of Walt Disney Productions, 1966-1985* - Mark Arnold 2013-10

When Walt Disney died in 1966, many predicted that it might be the end of Walt Disney Productions, but Walt had a number of ideas and concepts that lasted well into the next decade. He also left behind a well-established group of workers that hoped to continually answer the question, "What would Walt do?" with more magical creations that would dazzle and delight. With this book, author and historian Mark Arnold explores the major accomplishments of Walt Disney Productions during the years 1966 - 1985, paying particular attention to their theatrical film output, but also discussing the various new theme park attractions and the TV shows produced during that period. Things went well until the mid-1970s, when ideas started to run thin and repetition set in, causing shrinking box office success. By the 1980s, threats of corporate takeover were knocking at their door, at which time change had become unavoidable if Disney were to survive as an independent company. Disney had to change their already outdated methods of making movies and running a movie studio geared solely towards family entertainment. As a result, Michael Eisner took over and retooled Disney into the mega-empire that it is today. This is the story after Walt and before Michael...

The Urban Revolution - Henri Lefebvre 2003

Originally published in 1970, The Urban Revolution marked Henri Lefebvre's first sustained critique of urban society, a work in which he pioneered the use of semiotic, structuralist, and poststructuralist methodologies in analyzing the development of the urban environment. Although it is widely considered a foundational book in contemporary thinking about the city, The Urban Revolution has never been translated into English—until now. This first English edition, deftly translated by Robert Bononno, makes available to a broad audience Lefebvre's sophisticated insights into the urban dimensions of modern life. Lefebvre begins with the premise that the total urbanization of society is an inevitable process that demands of its critics new interpretive and perceptual approaches that recognize the urban as a complex field of inquiry. Dismissive of cold, modernist visions of the city, particularly those embodied by rationalist architects and urban planners like Le Corbusier, Lefebvre instead articulates the lived experiences of individual inhabitants of the city. In contrast to the ideology of urbanism and its reliance on commodification and bureaucratization—the capitalist logic of market and state—Lefebvre conceives of an urban utopia characterized by self-determination, individual creativity, and authentic social relationships. A brilliantly conceived and theoretically rigorous investigation into the realities and possibilities of urban space, The Urban Revolution remains an essential analysis of and guide to the nature of the city. Henri Lefebvre (d. 1991) was one of the most significant European thinkers of the twentieth century. His many books include The Production of Space (1991), Everyday Life in the Modern World (1994), Introduction to Modernity (1995), and Writings on Cities (1995). Robert Bononno is a full-time translator who lives in New York. His recent translations include The Singular Objects of Architecture by Jean Baudrillard and Jean Nouvel (Minnesota, 2002) and Cyberculture by Pierre Lévy (Minnesota, 2001).

Carl Rogers coined the term, 'The Basic Encounter Group' to identify encounter groups that operated on the principles of the person-centered approach. It is the contention that the person-centered Basic Encounter Group is quite unique and, in fact, offers a different paradigm for group therapy. Indeed, the application of the premises of the person-centered approach in group therapy requires a re-examination of many of the usual presuppositions about group function. This includes presuppositions about leader target population, size of group, establishment of goals and ground rules, and facilitator behavior.

**Esyllt T. Lawrence** - Josep-Vicent Garcia Raffi 2011-11-28

Esyllt T. Lawrence: una gal·lesa entre dracs es un estudio que pretende recuperar la trayectoria intelectual de la única persona que durante los años de la posguerra española hizo de puente entre el mundo catalán y el galés. Desde sus años de educación universitaria en Cambridge, la estancia en la Universidad de México, sus vínculos con el grupo de exiliados catalanes en este país y el matrimonio con el escritor Lluís Ferran de Pol, hasta los más de cuarenta años entre Arenys de Munt y Arenys de Mar, Esyllt T. Lawrence siempre

mostró un interés constante por las letras y por dos lenguas minoritarias, la galesa -la propia- y la catalana -la de adopción. Esta dedicación en cuerpo y alma se limitó a dar unos frutos que raramente traspasaron las fronteras del ensayo breve, de la traducción o del artículo periodístico y, por muchas razones que se explican en este volumen, Lawrence nunca vio publicada ninguna investigación más extensa de las que había emprendido con ilusión y esfuerzo. El reconocimiento de las instituciones catalanas con la Cruz de Sant Jordi a su trayectoria intelectual sólo es un testimonio de la admiración que esta mujer, que nunca olvidó sus raíces galesas, despertaba en todos aquellos que osaban acercarse a ella, tanto en Catalunya como en el País de Gales. Josep-Vicent Garcia Raffi es profesor de Lengua y Literatura de enseñanza media en la ciudad de Valencia. Es autor de diferentes estudios sobre literatura, sociolingüística y didáctica de la lengua, entre los cuales destacan los publicados sobre el escritor Lluís Ferran de Pol, como Lluís Ferran de Pol i Mèxic: literatura i periodisme (1998), y la recuperación de textos inéditos de este autor, Campo de concentración, 1939 (2002). Carme Manuel Cuenca es profesora de Literatura Norteamericana de la Universitat de València. Además de ser autora de numerosos artículos, libros y ediciones sobre varias obras de la literatura de los Estados Unidos, es directora de la colección Biblioteca Javier Coy de Estudios Norteamericanos (PUV) y codirectora de Biblioteca de Autoras Norteamericanas de Ediciones Ellago (Castellón). Ambos autores empezaron el estudio de las relaciones lingüísticas, culturales y literarias entre el galés y el catalán hace veinte años. Fruto de este interés son los diversos artículos y conferencias que han publicado e impartido, y la primera antología de poesía galesa traducida al catalán, Poesia galesa actual (Valencia, 1992).
